ART. 1 FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS

The Art. 3 of the Call for assignment of Financial Aid Benefits A.Y. 2024/2025 – issued by the Management Decree Ref. 0133626/2024 (hereinafter also “*the Call*”), is supplemented as follows:

ISEE/ISEEU Parificato and ISPE/ISPEU limits

Students requesting Financial Aid Benefits (hereinafter also “*DSU benefits*”) should have:

- an ISEE/ISEEU Parificato (issued for the sake of obtaining “*benefits for the right to higher education*”) not higher than **€ 26.306,25**;
- an ISPE/ISPEU calculated by dividing the ISP value (Assets Status Indicator provided by INPS) by the equivalency scale, not higher than **€ 57.187,53**.

Regardless of their merit, students whose ISEE/ISEEU Parificato or ISPE/ISPEU exceeds the abovementioned limits will be excluded from the assignment of DSU benefits.

Independent student

A student is defined as “independent” when the following requirements are met conjunctly:

- The student has had a different and separate residence from their family’s one for at least two years from the subscription of the Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica, and such a residence is not located in a property owned by their family;
- The student has been perceiving for two years an own, fiscally declared income derived from an employment relationship or assimilated no lower than **€ 9.000,00**. Such activities must not be carried out under an individual who is bonded to the student through kinship. If the independent student, basing on their civil status certificate, is cohabiting with another person, the incomes of both people must be considered mandatorily, even if they are not relatives.

ART. 2 DSU SCHOLARSHIPS: NUMBER AND VALUE

Art. 13 of the Call is supplemented as follows: there are **4.300** DSU scholarships available, divided up as below:

Scholarship amounts based on student's income brackets and geographical origin

The DSU scholarship's amounts, considering both the income bracket and student's geographic origin, are determined as follows:

Local student	
1 st bracket	€ 2.545,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 3.357,00
2 nd bracket	€ 2.115,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 2.927,00
3 rd bracket	€ 1.286,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 2.098,00

Commuter student	
1 st bracket	€ 3.905,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 4.717,00
2 nd bracket	€ 3.290,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 4.102,00
3 rd bracket	€ 2.417,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 3.229,00

Away from home student housed in Politecnico di Milano residences	
1 st bracket	€ 4.520,00 + housing + one free meal per day for a total of € 8.070,00
2 nd bracket	€ 3.467,00 + housing + one free meal per day for a total of € 7.017,00
3 rd bracket	€ 2.181,00+ housing + one free meal per day for a total of € 5.731,00

Away from home student housed in other accommodations, either public or private	
1 st bracket	€ 7.258,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 8.070,00
2 nd bracket	€ 6.205,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 7.017,00
3 rd bracket	€ 4.919,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 5.731,00

For students enrolled in the academic year 2024/2025 who are beneficiary of DSU for their additional term of all courses and students enrolled in the first year of Master of Science courses starting from the second term, the amount of their scholarship, as well as their services' deductions, will be reduced by 50%.

Students with certified disability of 66% or higher can get the annual amount of their scholarship increased up to 40% on top of the one they are entitled to, for a final benefit amounting to a maximum of:

€ 4.700,00 for local students
€ 6.604,00 for commuter students
€ 11.298,00 for away from home students

ART. 3 SCHOLARSHIP'S INCREASE ex DM 1320/2021

In light of article 3.5 of the DM 1320/2021, female students enrolled in STEM subjects (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) will benefit from an increase in their scholarship by 20%. As specified by the decree 13676/2022 of Ministero dell'Università e della Ricerca, the 20% increase of the scholarship for STEM students is not cumulable with the abovementioned increase of 15% reserved to students whose ISEE is inferior by 50% of the maximum limit of reference. Thus, the incrementation is calculated basing on the value of the scholarship which the female student is entitled to (corresponding to the amount of the second and third bracket).

ART. 4 GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN OF THE STUDENT: LOCAL, COMMUTER, AND AWAY FROM HOME

Article 14 of the Call is modified as follows:

The amount of the DSU scholarship is diversified basing on the geographic origin of the student. Specifically, the following three *status*es are considered: local, commuter, away from home.

Specifically, for DSU purposes a student is:

<p>“local”</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • resides in the Municipality in which the attended study program is based or in the nearby areas, as of article 4.8 of DPCM 9.4.2001 and whose commute from their domicile to their study site lasts up to 60 minutes by public transport; • attends the degree course <i>online</i>¹.
<p>“commuter”</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • resides in a Municipality from which it is possible to reach the study site within 60 and 90 minutes by public transport.
<p>“away from home”</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • resides in a Municipality from which it takes more than 90 minutes to reach the study site by public transport and who has, <u>therefore</u>, rented an accommodation for consideration close to where their course takes place².

The duration of the journey consists of the shortest time needed, basing on the public transportation timetable and excluding paths crossed on foot, or with private transport, or the waiting time in case of a single means of transport; only intermediate timing between two means of transport counts, in case of plurality of means used.

The travelling timing is based on the timetable of companies managing the public transport and can be verified through the following channels:

ART. 5 CANTEEN SERVICE DEDUCTION

Art. 19 of the Call is supplemented as follows:

a **deduction** equal to € 812,00 will be made from the amount of the DSU scholarship. The first 50% will be deducted from the first instalment of DSU scholarship, whilst the remaining 50% will be deducted from the second instalment.

Assigned students enrolled in the Online School of Engineering of Computing Systems may request for the abovementioned deduction not to be made. This request must be submitted by no later than **December 20th 2024** exclusively through the email³ address indicated on www.polimi.it/diritto-allo-studio (select: *Canteen Service*).

Submissions sent after the deadline and/or through a different channel than the indicated one will not be considered.

¹ Politecnico di Milano currently only offers the degree program in Engineering of Computing Systems online.

² The two conditions must coexist; hence, being a resident is not sufficient *per se*. Therefore, if the student resides in a location which is far from where the program takes place and they decide to live free of charge in a residence close to this location, they are considered a “commuter” student.

³ The email is managed via the ‘trouble ticket’ system.

ART. 6 ACCOMMODATION DEDUCTION FOR STUDENTS HOUSED IN POLITECNICO DI MILANO'S RESIDENCES

Art. 29 of the Call is supplemented as follows:

a **deduction** equal to € 2.786,00 will be made from the amount of the scholarship for students housed in Politecnico di Milano's residences.

ART. 7 ACCOMMODATION AT REDUCED RATE'S SLOTS: NUMBERS AND SITES

Art. 23 of DSU Call is modified as follows:

The 44 slots in double rooms of the Leonardo Da Vinci Residence (presently still under restoration) located on the first floor and available by August 2024 are added to the previously announced ones within the Milanese Campus.

Thus, the availability is updated as follows:
